## **MASSACHUSETTS BANKERS ASSOCIATION ANNOUNCES 2019 NEW ENGLAND SCHOOL FOR FINANCIAL STUDIES GRADUATES**

BOSTON, June 25, 2019 -- The Massachusetts Bankers Association (MBA) today announced the list of graduates of The New England School for Financial Studies. Eighty-four students from banks and other financial services-related firms completed graduation requirements for the school.

The Massachusetts Bankers Association established the School for Financial Studies in 1960 to provide opportunities for professional growth to those already in the industry. Over the years it has grown to meet the needs of the industry and today focuses heavily on financial management, technology, lending, marketing, and other strategic industry issues. It is sponsored by the Maine Bankers Association, Massachusetts Bankers Association, New Hampshire Bankers Association, Rhode Island Bankers Association and Vermont Bankers Association.

The students are encouraged to attend by their companies. "This was a terrific group," said Meghan McCarthy, director, Education. "They will be the senior bank officers and financial leaders of tomorrow, helping to shape an industry that is one of New England's largest employers."

To complete the school program, students enroll in a one-year course of study, including two one-week residential sessions held at the Babson Executive Conference Center. Students must complete five bank-specific research papers and participate in bank-management simulations presenting typical challenges facing today's senior bank managers.
